



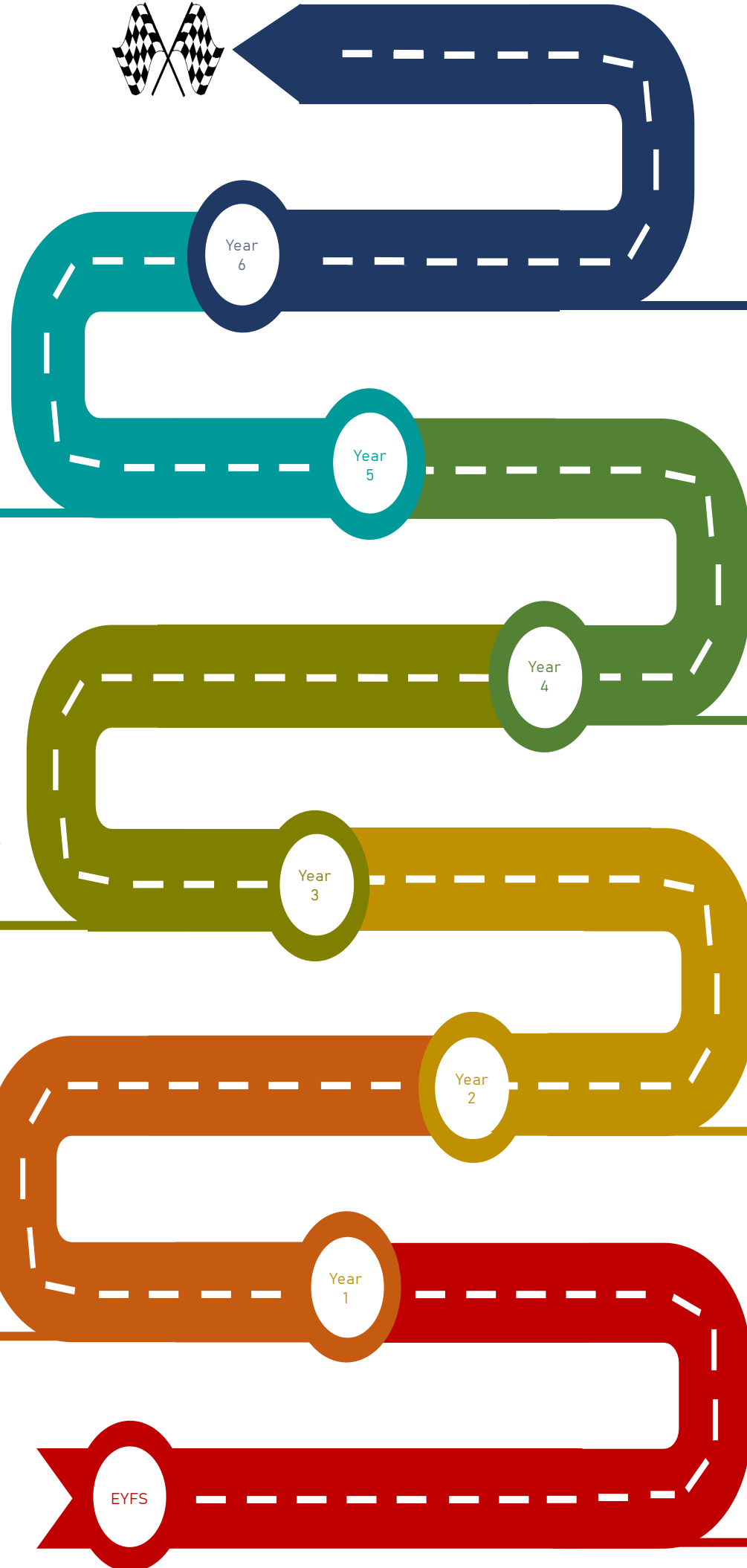

## Place Knowledge

Place Knowledge: Understand geographical similarities and differences through studying the human and physical geography for other areas around the world.

What makes a place unique and special?



Know key differences between living in the UK and in a country in either North or South America.

Collect information about a place and use it in a report.

Find possible answers to their own geographical questions.

Make detailed sketches and plans; improving their accuracy later.

Know at least five differences between living in the UK and a Mediterranean country.

Use correct geographical words to describe a place and the events that happen there.

Identify key features of a locality by using a map.

Find where they live on a map of the UK.

Explain what makes a locality special.

Know the main differences between a place in England and that of a small place in a non-European country.

Describe some places which are not near the school.

Describe a place outside Europe using geographical words.

Know features of hot and cold places in the world.

Explain the main features of a hot and cold place.

Answer some questions using different resources, such as books, the internet and atlases.

Know that there are different countries in the world and talk about the differences they have experienced or seen in photos. (UW - 3 and 4 year olds Dev. Matters)

Recognise some similarities and differences between life in this country and life in other countries. (UW - Reception Dev.Matters)

Recognise some environments that are different to the one in which they live. (UW - Reception Dev.Matters)

Explain some similarities and differences between life in this country and life in other countries, drawing on knowledge from stories, non-fiction texts and (when appropriate) maps. (PCC - EL6)

Know some similarities and differences between the natural world around them and contrasting environments, drawing on their experiences and what has been read in class. (NW - EL6)
