Hopefully, we are going to be heading into Summer and will be making the most of the good weather in school. Please can you make sure that all children have;

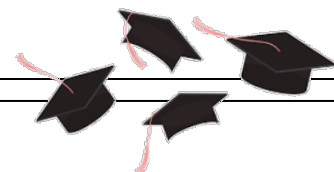
- A water bottle
