# Year 1 Newsletter Autumn 2



Our History question for this half term is "What was life like in the past?"

The children will be learning about how the past is different to now. They will look at old and new objects, thinking about how telephones have changed, how people's homes have changed and how transport has changed. In the final week of term, we will be looking at how schools have changed from the past to now.

#### **English**

This term, we will be working on writing a **recount** and an **information text**.

We will continue to work on using our phonics to spell words, using fingers spaces and putting capital letters and full stops in the correct places.

We will look at the features of an **information text** and we will write our own for others to follow.

Having the correct letter formation will help us to improve our stamina for writing so we will continue working on this.



#### Maths

Using both practical resources and mental methods, we will be moving on to count, write, order and compare numbers to twenty.

We will then further develop our addition and subtraction skills – working with these larger numbers.

#### **Art**

Our focus during Art Week will be the artist L S Lowry and we will be learning how to sketch and add detail to our sketches using different weights of pencil to add shading.



# <u>Reading</u>

<u>Children should be reading at least 5 times per</u> week.

Thank you to those of you who are listening to your children read at home regularly.

## Science

In this unit, the children will be identifying a range of everyday materials and distinguishing between the object itself and the material from which it is made
