What is cool about Stoke-on-Trent?

This half term the children will be learning about the geographical features in their local area.

As geographers, they will identify whether a landmark is a human or physical feature.

Through discussions, we will also talk about why landmarks are so important.

English

Over this half term the children will be learning how to innovate poems and stories. We will be consolidating our knowledge of verbs, nouns and adjectives. In our writing, we will be including different types of sentences such as questions and statements. As performers, we will recite, retell and talk about our favourite parts.

<u>Maths</u>

To start off the new school year we will be focusing on deepening our understanding of number and place value.

The children will learn how to partition numbers in various ways and as mathematicians they will identify patterns in number sequences.

To end the half term we will be learning a range of strategies to help us to solve addition and subtraction problems.

Please ask your child to show you the strategies they are being taught in maths lessons and use these to support them in completing their home learning tasks.

Reading

Please make sure that your child reads every night and that their diary is signed by an adult. If your child reads more than five times a week they will be entered into the weekly prize draw and they could win a brand new book!
