Year 6 Newsletter Spring 2

Our topic this half term will be history-based, asking the question 'What was life like in post-war Britain?' Our learning will focus on the changes in society after World War 2, looking at key events such as the creation of the Commonwealth and the introduction of the National Health Service.

<u>English</u>

Over the remainder of the term, we will continue to study 'Holes' by Louis Sachar. Our focus genre will be persuasive writing, with the children looking at how authors use language to influence the reader.

Towards the end of the term, we will spend some time looking at 'Love That Dog' by Sharon Creech, giving the children the opportunity to develop their poetry skills. In particular, we will be looking at narrative poetry and how prose and poetry differ.



Maths

Our mathematics this half term will develop the children's understanding of ratio, algebra and area and perimeter.

Please continue to support your children in learning and recalling their multiplication and division facts. All the children have login details for Times Table Rockstars in their reading diaries.

<u>SATs</u>

As we progress through this term, the children will continue their preparation for their SATs tests. They may receive some additional homework and may want to start to do some revision for the tests at home. However, we would ask that you <u>do not use previous years'</u> test papers as a form of revision with your child

as we use these in school as part of our preparation. We will also be providing the children with revision books that they will be using in class to support their test preparations.

Reading

To help the children to become Star Readers, we ask that the children read at home each night to an adult. We expect that the children should be reading <u>at least five times per week.</u> This can either be their school reading book or their Recommended Read.

Once they have read to you, please ensure that you sign their diary.
